In Matthew 28: 16-20, Jesus sends his closest followers out into the world to make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them, and teaching them to obey all that he had commanded. This has come to be known as “The Great Commission.”

On our retreat at Pyoca, we will explore the content of this commission, God’s mission to bring salvation to the world through discipleship, our calling to participate with God in this work, and the particular challenges of doing so in our contemporary setting.

John Franke is the theologian-in-residence at Second Presbyterian Church in Indianapolis, Indiana. He is also affiliate professor of theology at Christian Theological Seminary, and general coordinator for the Gospel and Our Culture Network in North America. He holds the DPhil degree from the University of Oxford, and has spoken on the relationships between the gospel, theology, mission, and culture through the U.S. and around the world. John is married to Debra, and they have one son, JJ, who graduated from Messiah College this past spring.

* If you would like to go but would prefer not to drive yourself, we would be happy to make arrangements for carpooling, either on Friday evening or on Saturday.

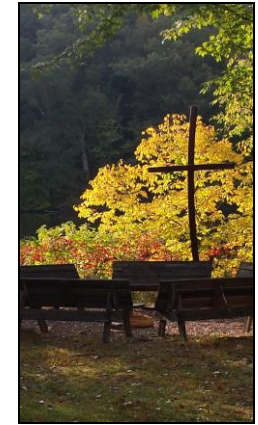
